

Blauherd, Zermatt.

Sun-kissed scene of a thousand adventures – that’s Blauherd. Viewed from Sunnegga-Blauherd area, the Matterhorn – along with numerous other four-thousand-metre-peaks (13,000 feet) as well as impressive glaciers – presents itself at its most stunning. Blauherd is the starting point to numerous themed hiking trails. One of them is the worldwide known 5-Seenweg (Five Lakes Walk), which takes about three hours. Within 20 minutes only, guests can reach the first idyllic mountain lake, the Stellisee, at 2,537 metres (8,323 feet) altitude. It reflects the iconic Matterhorn on its glassy surface and is most likely Zermatt’s most photographed mountain lake.

Top attractions

- Unique view of the Matterhorn.
- Starting point to numerous themed hiking trails:
 - Five Lakes Walk to Sunnegga
 - Flower hike from Tuftern to Sunnegga
 - Panorama hike to Ritzengrad
 - Marmot hike to Sunnegga
- New mountain carts from Blauherd to Sunnegga.
- New kiosk with souvenirs, snacks and drinks, as well as tickets.

Good to know

- Altitude: 2,571 metres (8,435 feet).
- Arrival: by train from Brig/Visp to Zermatt, on foot or by local bus to valley station Sunnegga-Rothorn.
- Travel time: 15 minutes from Zermatt.
- Timetable: operates year-round (maintenance 24 April to 14 June 2019 and autumn 2019).
- For operating times, see official timetable Zermatt Bergbahnen AG (ZBAG): matterhornparadise.ch/timetable.

Sales information

- Holders of a Swiss Travel Pass, a Swiss Travel Pass Flex (on validated travel days) or a Swiss Half Fare Card are eligible for a 50% discount.
- Children up to their 9th birthday travel free of charge.



- Children from their 9th up to their 16th birthday travel free of charge when accompanied by at least one parent with the Swiss Family Card.
