

Central Alps Passes PostBus Route.

Pure Alpine magic: tackle four of the most impressive Alpine pass roads and negotiate a staggering total of 10,366 metres (34,000 feet) of altitude by Postbus – all in one single day. This 4-passes-route of PostBus is the ultimate experience for Alpine enthusiasts! On Grimsel, travellers trundle past glittering reservoir lakes and enjoy many arresting views. Nufenen Pass, Switzerland's highest Alpine transition negotiable by vehicle, truly gets pulses racing. The Gotthard, nicknamed "King of Mountain Passes", has been an important north-south trans-Alpine connection since the times of the Roman Empire. En route to the Susten Pass, the tireless Postbus crosses no fewer than 25 bridges – and passes through just as many tunnels.

- All Swiss Travel System tickets are valid.
