

Glacier 3000 – Les Diablerets – Gstaad.

Cableway, architecture, mountain scenery and adventure – travellers will experience all of it and then some on this fabulous journey to a unique glacier world. Guests arrive at the summit to a spectacular view of the summit station “Glacier 3000” designed by architect Mario Botta. Then, the revelation of a stunning panorama of no fewer than 24 snow-capped four-thousanders (13,000 feet mountain giants) will leave them breathless. Among the surrounding peaks are Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau, the Matterhorn, Grand Combin and even Mont Blanc in the distance.

Top attractions

- Peak Walk by Tissot – first suspension footbridge spanning two peaks.
- Alpine Coaster – adventurous toboggan run up to 6 metres (20 feet) above the ground, sporting a 520° circle, steep curves, surges and jumps.
- Dog sledge ride, snow bus, all-year glacier hiking trails, cross-country ski trail (October to June).
- Watch & souvenir shop at 3,000 metres (9,850 feet).

Good to know

- Arrival: Postbus from Gstaad or Les Diablerets to Col du Pillon, then aerial cableway to summit station Glacier 3000, operates daily from 09.00h to 16.30h at 20-minute intervals. Travel time: 15 minutes. Closed for maintenance from 7 to 25 October 2019.
- Peak Walk by Tissot: suspension footbridge of 107 metres (351 feet) length, open year-round, free of charge.
- Alpine coaster open daily from May to October, from 09.15h to 16.30h, depending on weather conditions. Toboggan run may be closed in case of heavy snowfalls, rains or strong breeze.
- Summit restaurant with unique panoramic view on majestic Alpine scenery.
- Groups: restaurant Botta (summit station) with 300 seats, terrace with bar, modern conference facilities.



Sales information

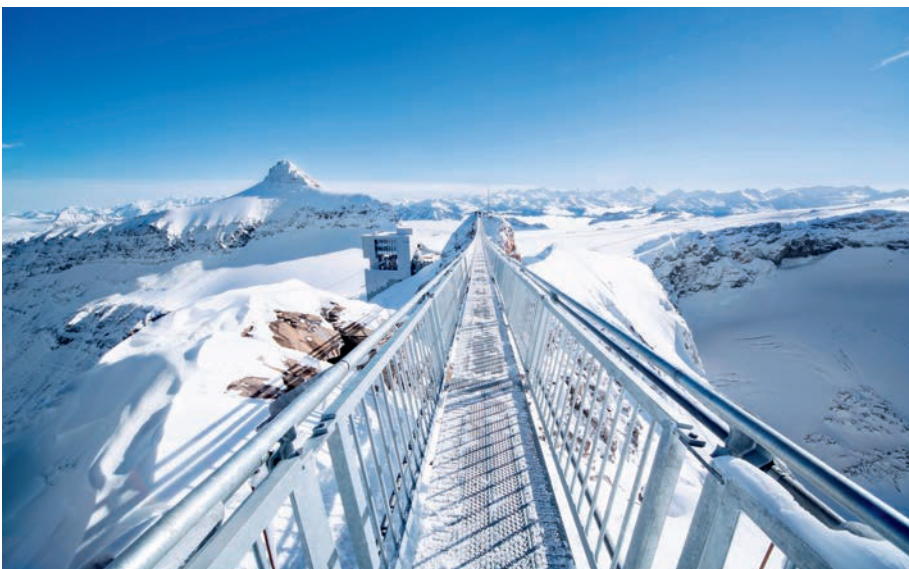
