

# Grindelwald-First – Top of Adventure.

“First” is an ideal starting point for excursions – action-packed adventures included: on the free “First Cliff Walk presented by Tissot” with a breathtaking view onto the Eiger north face, on the First Flyer over a distance of 800 metres (0.5 miles), on the First Glider – soaring through the air at a speed of up to 83 km/h (50 mph) – rushing to Schreckfeld in a mountain cart or riding a trottbike scooter down into the valley – adrenaline rushes and thrill of speed are guaranteed! Children may frolic around on the 700 square-metre Alpine playground at the intermediate station Bort or on the First Bagjump on First. The idyllic area around Lake Bachalpsee offers some peace and quiet.

### Top attractions

- Free-of-charge First Cliff Walk presented by Tissot.
- Lake Bachalpsee.
- First Flyer from First to Schreckfeld.
- First Glider from Schreckfeld to First and back.
- First Mountain Cart from Schreckfeld to Bort.
- Trottbike scooter from Bort to Grindelwald.
- Adventure playground at Bort station.
- First Bagjump.

### Good to know

- Operates daily from 24 November 2018 to 27 October 2019.
- Arrival: train from Interlaken Ost to Grindelwald, then on foot (10 minutes) to lower station of First aerial cableway.
- Accommodation at the Mountain Restaurant First.
- Marmot Educational Trail with family adventure barbecue area.
- Souvenir shop at the Mountain Restaurant First.
- Tip: hiking trail from upper terminal First to Lake Bachalpsee (50 minutes).

### Sales information

- Holders of a Swiss Travel Pass, a Swiss Travel Pass Flex (on validated travel days) or a Swiss Half Fare Card are eligible for a 50% discount.
- Children from their 6th birthday up to their 16th birthday travel free of charge when accompanied by at least one parent with the Swiss Family Card.
