

Lake Lucerne Cruises.



Not only the historical sites but also the breath-taking panorama around Lake Lucerne can be savoured from the perspective of a boat – admire attractions up close as well as in the distance! A trip to the origins of the confederation, a cruise to the foot of Rigi (“Queen of the mountains”), direct access to the world’s steepest cog railway up Pilatus, or a leisurely lunch cruise on a historic steamer: Those are among the many highlights on and around Lake Lucerne.

Good to know

- Boat cruises during 365 days a year.
- Several round cruises from/to Lucerne between 1 and 5.5 hours duration are available.
- Unlimited travel with Swiss Travel Pass on all scheduled boats; Discount on one-hour cruise on Panorama-Yacht Saphir with Swiss Travel Pass.
- Boats headed for Vitznau (Rigi) cast off from pier 1; boats headed for Alpnachstad (Pilatus) cast off from pier 2; the Panorama-Yacht Saphir casts off from pier 7 (“Schweizerhofquai”).
- Ticket and information counter is located near pier 1, opposite Lucerne main station.
- On motor vessels: 2nd class is located on the main deck (entrance) and 1st class on the upper deck; on steamboats: the salon at the stern also belongs to 1st class; no classes on the Panorama-Yacht Saphir.
- All scheduled boats have an on-board restaurant.

- For individual travellers (up to 9 persons) without catering no reservation is required.
- For groups (10 or more persons) reservation is required (no surcharge); prior menu selection (where applicable) is mandatory.
- Reservation required for Lunch Cruise/Lunch Steamer (before 11.00h) and Sunset Cruise (before 15.00h).
