

# Pilatus.

Close to Lucerne and easily accessible by public transport, the Pilatus at 2,132 metres (6,995 feet) altitude is the ideal adventure mountain for the whole family. Among its many cool and exciting highlights are the world's steepest cog railway, two aerial cableways and Central Switzerland's biggest rope park. Additionally, five restaurants and two hotels provide much needed refreshment and welcome accommodation, as well as great workshop and banquet facilities in a wonderfully scenic location.

## Top attractions

- The world's steepest cog railway (48% gradient) from Alpnachstad to Pilatus Kulm (May to November).
- Historic mountain hotel Pilatus-Kulm at 2,132 metres (6,995 feet).
- Golden round trip Luzern – Kriens – Fräkmüntegg – Pilatus Kulm – Alpnachstad – Luzern (by bus, aerial cableway, cog railway and boat).

## Good to know

- Access via Kriens by aerial cableway or via Alpnachstad on the world's steepest cog railway.
- Access from Luzern station to Kriens/Zentrum Pilatus by bus No. 1.
- Aerial cableway: year-round operation from Kriens, except from 21 October to 08 November 2019 (revision).
- Travel time to summit: approx. 40 minutes.

## Sales information

- Holders of a Swiss Travel Pass, a Swiss Travel Pass Flex (on validated travel days) or a Swiss Half Fare Card are eligible for a 50% discount.
- Children from their 6th up to their 16th birthday travel free of charge when accompanied by at least one parent with the Swiss Family Card.
