

Rochers-de-Naye.

In this wonderful location, travellers experience a unique panoramic view spanning the Swiss and French Alps from Eiger to Mont-Blanc and further to Lake Geneva. At 2,000 metres (6,560 feet) altitude, visitors enjoy beautiful hikes with attractions like colonies of marmots from three continents and hundreds of plants from around the world. What many don't know: in December, Father Christmas resides on the Rochers-de-Naye...

Top attractions

- Free admission to Marmot Paradise and La Rambertia, a botanic Alpine garden (open only during summer).
- Father Christmas welcoming children on the summit during Christmas season, at special price – limited number of seats.

Good to know

- Open year-round.
- Travel time to summit: 49 minutes; hourly departures from Montreux between 08.17h and 15.17h, from Rochers-de-Naye between 09.11h and 16.11h, later rides available in summer.
- Summit restaurants.

Sales information

- Holders of a Swiss Travel Pass or a Swiss Travel Pass Flex travel free of charge from Montreux to Haut-de-Caux on validated travel days and are eligible for a 50% discount from Haut-de-Caux to Rochers-de-Naye.
- Children from their 6th up to their 16th birthday travel free of charge when accompanied by at least one parent with the Swiss Family Card.
