- Arrival: from Interlaken Ost by train to Lauterbrunnen, then by Postbus to the lower terminus Stechelberg.
- Operates year-round.
- Section Mürren-Schilthorn closed for maintenance from 23 to 26 April 2019 and from 11 November to 06 December 2019.
- Cableway departs from Stechelberg and Mürren every 30 minutes.
- Travel time to summit: 32 minutes from Stechelberg.
- Newly renovated Piz Gloria, including 360° restaurant, Top Shop and Take Away.

Sales information

- Holders of a Swiss Travel Pass or a Swiss Travel Pass Flex travel free of charge to Schilthorn–Piz Gloria on validated travel days, Swiss Half Fare Card holders are eligible for a 50% discount.

Mountain highlights.

Skyline View.

Perfect – before and after the mountain exploration. Within 45 minutes, the 360° restaurant Piz Gloria completes one full rotation while the breathtaking panorama – a genuine natural spectacle with 200 mountain summits – glides past in silence. The restaurant serves to the table and offers a wide range of delicious food, from snacks to regional dishes.



Bond World.

The interactive exhibition “Bond World” immerses visitors in seven key scenes from the James Bond movie “On Her Majesty’s Secret Service”. The tour allows guests to experience the film up close. They get detailed information about the making-of, see the original screenplay and may even test their own James Bond skills: from the expert hat-toss in Miss Money-penny’s office, via a helicopter simulator, to an exciting bobsleigh chase.

Thrill Walk.

A veritable adrenaline rush awaits visitors on the “Thrill Walk”: The 200 metre (656 feet) cliff walk starts at the viewing platform, passes below the cableway station and back towards the station Birg over steel rope, glass floor and grid. An unforgettable adventure with unmatched views.
