

# Titlis.

The excursion up the Titlis – one stretch by “Rotair”, the world’s first revolving aerial cableway – is a real treat: Stunning Alpine scenery around the 3,000 metre (9,850 feet) summit, tempting restaurants, sun terraces and a “Glacier Cave” (free admission) all blend into an outstanding Swiss Alpine experience. The “Titlis Cliff Walk”, Europe’s highest suspension footbridge, is not for the faint of heart. The airy chairlift “Ice Flyer” takes visitors high above the Titlis glacier to the “Titlis Glacier Park” to enjoy its many free attractions.

## Top attractions

- “Titlis Cliff Walk” – Europe’s highest suspension footbridge.
- Chairlift “Ice Flyer” – slides over impressive, up to 10 metres (33 feet) deep crevasses.
- Titlis Rotair – the world’s first aerial cableway revolving 360° around its own axis.

## Good to know

- Operates daily from 08.30h to 16.40h, except from 04 to 15 November 2019 (closed for maintenance); section Engelberg-Trübsee is served without interruption.
- Travel time to summit: approx. 30 minutes.
- Free of charge: return trip to Titlis Glacier Park on the “Ice Flyer” chairlift, admission to Glacier Cave and access to “Titlis Cliff Walk”.
- Summer fun slide park, open May to July.
- Winter fun slide park on Trübsee, open December to April.
- Railway adventure: combination with Luzern-Engelberg Express.

## Sales information

- Holders of a Swiss Travel Pass, a Swiss Travel Pass Flex (on validated travel days) or a Swiss Half Fare Card are eligible for a 50% discount.
- Children from their 6th up to their 16th birthday travel free of charge when accompanied by at least one parent with the Swiss Family Card.
