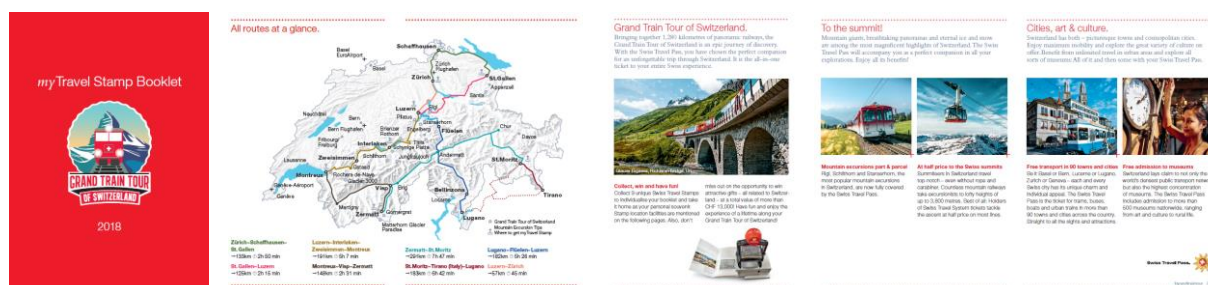




# Grand Train Tour of Switzerland - myTravel Stamp Booklet 2018.

For 2018, the Association Grand Train Tour of Switzerland is launching the third edition of its GTTOS *myTravel* Stamp Booklet. Incoming tourists from South Korea, Japan, China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Thailand, Malaysia and Singapore, and now also from North America, receive a free copy of the GTTOS *myTravel* Stamp Booklet (a booklet to collect stamps) with the purchase of a Swiss Travel Pass in their respective home markets or in Switzerland.

Accordingly, the booklets will be handed out proactively at six SBB train stations.



## Added value and content for the client

- St. Moritz via Tirano to Lugano on board the Bernina Express / St. Moritz to Lugano on board the Palm Express
- Lugano to Luzern on board the Wilhelm Tell Express
- Luzern to Zürich
