



## Area of validity 2019: Mountains included in the Swiss Travel Pass.

**The mountain railways Brunni, Rigi, Schilthorn and Stanserhorn remain fully included in the area of validity of the Swiss Travel Pass.**

The Federal Office of Transport (FOT) has revised the decision to adjust the area of validity of the Swiss Travel Pass. **Brunni, Rigi, Schilthorn** and **Stanserhorn** remain fully included in the area of validity of the Swiss Travel Pass for 2019.

As a result of this decision, the area of validity of the Swiss Travel Pass for 2019 remains unchanged as against 2018: The mentioned mountain railways will remain 100% included in the area of validity of the Swiss Travel Pass. On all other mountain railways, travellers will continue to receive a 50% discount (exception: Jungfrauoch 25%).

The production of the Swiss Travel System AG brochures, namely the Swiss Travel System Map 2019 and the STS Area of Validity Map 2019, will be delayed by this decision. The new brochures will be available for ordering before the end of February 2019.

As a temporary solution, printed versions of the **STS Area of Validity Map 2018** may be handed out with the sale of physical Swiss Travel System tickets.

Holders of a Swiss Travel Pass will continue to benefit from consistently attractive services during 2019: With one single ticket, travellers can explore the entire country by train bus and boat during 3, 4, 8 or 15 days. The popular panoramic lines of Glacier Express, Bernina Express, GoldenPass MOB Panoramic, Gotthard Panorama Express and Luzern-Interlaken Express are all included, as is public transportation in 90 towns and cities. Furthermore, Swiss Travel Pass holders enjoy free admission to more than 500 museums throughout Switzerland. **As of 1 January 2019**, more museums are added to the list: for example, admission to **the visitors' centre of Chocolat Frey** is now also free of charge with the Swiss Travel Pass.
