The BLS RegioExpress Lötschberger turns the scenic ride along the historic Lötschberg mountain route from Berne to Brig into an extraordinary experience. Railway and nature enthusiasts enjoy many lovely views into the Kandertal Valley as well as the breathtaking rides over the viaducts at the north and south ramps.

Operation

- Hourly connections Bern–Kandersteg–Brig
- Operation to/from Domodossola at two-hourly intervals

Facilities on the train

- Large windows with panoramic view in 1st and 2nd class
- Wheelchair-accessible compartment and toilet available
- Low-floor access, power outlets in 1st and 2nd class

No catering on the train

Reservation and surcharges

Seat reservation for individual travellers possible but not required (surcharge of CHF 5 per seat and route)
