

Travelling by train from Austria.

With the comfortable Railjet or the Eurocity trains, travellers arrive in Zurich daily at two-hour intervals. Perfect onward connections to all Swiss regions are guaranteed. Even better: the Nightjet links Vienna as well as Graz to Zurich “in sleep mode”, so to speak.

- Cannot be combined with other discounts
- Limited offer of saver tickets available
- Seat reservation required and not included (payable separately depending on the train)
