

## Rothorn, Zermatt.

The arrival by cableway immediately reveals a stunning view of the highest mountain giants of the Valais and of course of the mountain of mountains – the Matterhorn. It is an ideal starting point for seasoned hikers in summer and offers access to a number of ski slopes in winter.

### Operation

Year-round operation, except during revision from 19 Apr–26 Jun 2021 and from 04 Oct–30 Nov 2021

### Top attractions

- Unique view of the Matterhorn
- Starting point for many mountain hikes and themed hiking trails (e.g. Peak Collection, Path to Freedom, Chamois Trail and Panoramic Trail)
- Moonlight descent in winter
- Sunrise rides for groups bookable on request

### Arrival

- Train from Brig/Visp to Zermatt, on foot or by free e-bus (green line) to the valley station Sunnegga-Rothorn
- Travel time from Zermatt: 25 minutes

### Catering, accommodation and shopping

- Mountain restaurant “Pizzeria-Ristorante Rothorn” offering Italian specialities
- Kiosk Blauherd for tickets, information, souvenirs, snacks and beverages
- Catering and accommodation facilities on Fluhalp

### Tickets, reservation and surcharges

- 50% discount with Swiss Travel Pass (Flex) and Swiss Half Fare Card, no discount with ER/IR
- Children up to their 9th birthday travel free of charge
