2 Changes in price 2020

2.1 Group tariffs 2020

From the change of timetable on 15.12.2019, new group tariffs apply on the Swiss railway network:

- 30% discount on the ticket price from 10 persons and more. No free seats
- 50 % discount for children/juveniles up to the age of 25

4.1 Reservation

Groups: Reservations are accepted by Railservice in exactly the same way as for 1st & 2nd class Individual passengers: All the well-known sales channels (rail ticketing, Euronet etc.) or the Glacier Express B2B shop (also see 6.)

4.2 Cancellation conditions

Please note the special <u>cancellation conditions</u> for Excellence Class.

NEW 5. New ticketing policy

For trips taking place from 15.12.2019, vouchers for obtaining tickets will be replaced by etickets which will be sent directly by mail. These no longer have to be exchanged at the ticket desk. E-tickets can still be paid for on account or using a credit card.
