

Brienzi Rothorn Railway – Realise your dreams.

Since 1892, the Brienzi Rothorn Railway has been steaming its way up to Mount Brienzer Rothorn (2,351 metres/ 7,712 feet above sealevel). The stretch of 7.6 kilometres (4.7 miles) length has a maximum gradient of 25 percent. This steam railway negotiates a difference in altitude of 1,678 metres (5,505 feet) and passes through six tunnels and numerous galleries. A nostalgic locomotive burns some 350 kilos of coal and produces 2,000 litres of steam per return journey.

Top attractions

- Steam railway.
- Mountain restaurant Rothorn Kulm with panorama terrace.
- Steam Sausage Express – boiler sausages out of the steam kettle.
- Workshop visits.
- Salon Rouge – railway nostalgia combined with finest onboard cuisine.
- Rides in the driver's cabin.

Good to know

- Operates daily to Rothorn Kulm from 01 Jun to 20 Oct 2019.
- Scheduled rides from 08.36h to 17.40h (last descent).
- Limited service to Planalp only: 11 to 31 May and 21 Oct to 03 Nov 2019.
- Travel time to summit: approx. 60 minutes.
- Arrival at Brienzi by boat or train, then approx. 3 walking minutes to lower terminus.
- Summit restaurant with accommodation.
- Steam Sausage Express: Wednesdays at 10.00h, starting June.
- Panoramic view onto 693 mountain peaks from Rothorn Kulm.
- Hiking trails rich in variety.

Sales information

- 2 children up to their 16th birthday travel free of charge per accompanying adult.
- Holders of a Swiss Travel Pass, a Swiss Travel Pass Flex (on validated travel days) or a Swiss Half Fare Card are eligible for a 50% discount.
- Free ride on one's birthday.
