

Glacier Express.

From Zermatt to St. Moritz – across 291 bridges, through 91 tunnels, passing its highest point (the Oberalp Pass) at 2,033 metres (6,670 feet) altitude: The ride on the Glacier Express is a classic among the Swiss panoramic journeys. It will undoubtedly turn into an unforgettable experience – whatever the season.

Good to know

- Headphones as well as an information brochure (in German, English, French, Italian, Chinese and Japanese plus 2 music channels) are available free of charge. During the journey, the most interesting landmarks along the route are pointed out and explained.
- Lunch available at the seat (reservation required): 3-course menu: CHF 45, dish of the day: CHF 32, or à la carte.
- Panoramic coaches 1st and 2nd class, Excellence Class, open-plan coach with tables, air conditioning, info channel.
- In the 1st class of each Glacier Express train, there is a wheelchair space as well as a restroom for passengers with limited mobility. Reservation of seat no 11 at the railway station counter or at the travel agency no later than 24 hours before start of the journey.
- Upon showing the ticket, a Glacier Express Certificate can be obtained at the railway stations Zermatt, Andermatt or St. Moritz.
- Animals are not permitted onboard.
- Afternoon trains (906/907), Brig–St. Moritz/Chur–Zermatt:
 - Ideal opportunity to include the Glacier Express in the arrival journey or in one's afternoon program.
 - Impressive evening atmosphere with wonderful light conditions.
 - Dinner at the seat.

- Valid ticket and seat reservations are required. Seat reservations are subject to a surcharge.
