In over 90 years, this classic among the Swiss panoramic trains has never ceased to amaze its guest.

## Operation

Winter: 11 Dec 2021–13 May 2022, Summer: 14 May–23 Oct 2022

## Facilities on the train

- Panoramic coaches in 1st and 2nd class, Excellence Class (all with tables and air conditioning)
- Power outlets at each table, sun protection films on roof windows and lowerable windows at all entrance doors
- One available wheelchair space on Glacier Express and one wheelchair-accessible toilet in 1st class. Reservation at the station counter or via travel agency no later than 24 hours prior to departure

## Services

- Touristic announcements via headphones (GE, EN, IT, FR, CN, JP); free headphones, information brochures and two music channels available
- Modern passenger information system with integrated infotainment (GE, FR, EN, IT, JP, CN, KOR, THAI)
- Receipt of a Glacier Express certificate on presentation of the ticket at the railway stations of Zermatt, Andermatt and St. Moritz

## Catering

- 1st and 2nd class: lunch served at the seat, three-course meal CHF 47, daily menu CHF 34, à la carte
- Excellence Class: 7-course meal at the seat, wine pairing and soft drinks included



## Reservation and surcharges

- Seat surcharge per person and direction (seat reservation required):
  - 11 Dec 2021–13 May 2022: long section CHF 39, short section CHF 29
  - 14 May–23 Oct 2022: long section CHF 49, short section CHF 39
- Excellence Class (11 Dec 2021–23 Oct 2022, except from 21 Mar–08 Apr 2022) surcharge on 1st class ticket: CHF 420. Seat reservation is required for each Excellence Class guest including children up to 16 years of age. Fare: 1st class ticket plus seat reservation. Prices subject to change
