

GoldenPass Panoramic.



The train window becomes a giant movie screen: Lake Geneva, lovely vineyards, and impressive castles take turns with rolling Swiss hillsides. On the GoldenPass Panoramic, this whole experience needs only one single train. Live cinema at its best.

Operation

- Year-round operation
- Hourly departures from Montreux and Zweisimmen with standardised travel times and stops from morning till night

Facilities on the train

- Panoramic coaches in 1st as well as 2nd class
- All GoldenPass Panoramic trains offer low-floor access and a wheelchair-accessible toilet. No seat reservation is available for the wheelchair area. The Rail Center SBB at Brig needs to be notified about transportation of passengers with limited mobility
- At irregular intervals, some trains include coaches with VIP seats with driver's view. During the week (Monday–Friday), these premium seats can be reserved after paying a surcharge to the train personnel. Four services on Saturdays and Sundays feature front-view VIP seats that can be booked online in the webshop at mob.ch – up to seven days before the travel date

Services

There is currently no on-board catering service available for individual travellers. Groups of 10 or more passengers can book catering to the seat in advance via goldenpass@mob.ch



Reservation and surcharges

- No seat reservation required in addition to valid ticket
- Seat reservation for individual travellers because of limited capacity recommended but not required, fee: CHF 9. Seat reservation available via mob.ch; always as of timetable change in December for the following calendar year
- For groups of 10 or more persons: seat reservation required and subject to a surcharge of CHF 7 per person. Allocation of seats for groups in 2nd class: 9 days prior to departure; in 1st class: on-site by the train staff. Contact: goldenpass@mob.ch or phone +41 (0)21 989 81 51
