

Rochers-de-Naye.

A unique panoramic view over the Swiss and French Alps: from Eiger to Mont-Blanc and onto Lake Geneva. The cog railway takes guests to an altitude of 2,000 metres (6,650 feet) and thereby to numerous possibilities for adventure and discovery.

Operation

- Year-round operation
- From 06 Jan–06 Apr 2021, the stretch from Haut-de-Caux to Rochers-de-Naye is not operated on Mondays and Tuesdays

Top attractions

- Free admission to the “Marmot Paradise” animal park and “La Rambertia”, a botanical Alpine garden with more than 800 species of mountain plants from all over the world (only open during summer)
- Via ferrata from Jaman to Rochers-de-Naye
- During Christmas season, Father Christmas welcomes children on the summit (special offer available on-site, limited number of seats)

Arrival

- From Montreux station by cog railway via Glion and Caux directly to the summit (no change of transportation)
- Travel duration to the summit: 49 minutes
- Hourly departures from Montreux between 08.17 h and 15.17 h / from Rochers-de-Naye between 09.11 h and 16.11 h, later rides available in summer

Catering, accommodation and shopping

- Mountain restaurant at the railway station
- No overnight stay possible

Tickets, reservations and surcharges

Free ride with Swiss Travel Pass (Flex) from Montreux to Haut-de-Caux, 50% discount from Haut-de-Caux to Rochers-de-Naye, 50% discount with Swiss Half Fare Card, no discount with ER/IR
