









Pick-up / Delivery	Express: Same day pick-up and delivery
Pick-up	09.00 h latest
Delivery	18.00 h latest
Group size	Minimum 10 persons, maximum 50 items of luggage Others on request
Transport price	CHF 300 per transport – net without commission
Precondition	Transportation is only possible if each person holds a valid ticket for the entire transport distance
Booking change / cancellation	Up to 09.00 h (CET/CEST) on the day before start of transport, free of charge / later 50% of cost
Booking deadline	5 days before transportation at the latest
